THREE THINGS YOU WILL NOT HEAR ON THE DAY OF JUDGMENT

The concept of a coming day of judgment is not a fantasy or fable. It is a fact. Paul told the people in ancient Athens that God "hath appointed a day, in which God will judge the world in righteousness," Acts 17:31. All people that have ever lived on the earth will be brought before the throne of God, and His glorious Son will judge each one of them, Matt. 25:31-33.
