## Minister's Corner

WRITTEN IN OUR HEARTS  
 Isa 55:11 So shall my word be that goeth forth out of my mouth: it shall not return unto me void, but it shall accomplish that which I please, and it shall prosper in the thing whereto I sent it. A few years ago I married a couple that insisted on using a white bible in their services. As the two placed their hands on the white Bible, they pledged that the Bible will be the foundation of their home. But what was written in the Bible was not written in their hearts. They carried the Bible on their honeymoon, but they did not read it. In their home, the white Bible was given a place in the living room, but never opened. There was no family prayer, no reading of the scriptures, and they even became unfaithful to the Lord. In just a few months, I received a phone call from the husband who told me that his wife had become involved with another man. The marriage ended in divorce. Today, he still has the white Bible stored in his home, but

it brings tears instead of joy. I believed that all of this happened because the message of the white Bible was not in their hearts. God said, "THESE WORDS, WHICH I COMMAND THEE THIS DAY, SHALL BE IN THINE HEART", Deut. 6:6. "Receive my instruction, and not silver; and knowledge rather than choice gold. For wisdom is better than rubies; and all the things that may be desired are not to be compared to it," Prov. 8:10-11. A happy marriage is the will of God, nothing more, nothing less, nothing else. I can preach my heart out about a happy marriage, but if someone does not desire the will of God more than his own pleasure, nothing will change. How we respond to God's will is determined by our desires. Whatever is in our hearts is what will come out of our lives. At the heart of every problem is a problem of the heart. It must be man's will to do God's will in God's ways only. Unless God is

given His rightful place in our lives, he does not have a place in our lives. You will find the mind of God in His Bible, white or black or any color. It is still God's word and His will. God has taken the time to write His will in the Bible. We should take the time to read it, to understand it, and most of all, to do His will. Take the time to read the Bible with a godly attitude. It's not the lack of time, but it is the lack of interested in reading God's Bible. The white Bible was given the right place in the house, but its contents were not written in their heart. The will of God was not written in the heart of the Church of Laodicea, Rev 3:15-16. Therefore, they had lost the capacity to get excited about Christ. Our secrets are not secrets to God. Some rush through the reading of God's word and fail to truly listen to God. Our attitude toward the Bible will determine our memories for tomorrow. We interpret what we see in the light of what we believe.
